Key Standards for Green Products	Requirements
Performance	Green products must perform to acceptable standards, so as not to make cleaning tasks more difficult.
Concentrates	For the most impact, products should be as concentrated as is practical.
Health Concerns	
Oral and Inhalation Toxicity	When used properly, long-term exposure or accidental ingestion should produce no serious ill effects.
Skin and Eye Irritation	Limit or prohibit ingredients known to be skin sensitizers, or must pass skin sensitization test.
Fragrances	Screen for sensitization, or must meet Code of Practice for the International Fragrance Association.
Neurotoxins and Central Nervous System Depressants	Limits or prohibits compounds of this type.
Endocrine Disruptors or Modifiers	Limits or prohibits compounds of this type.
Environmental Safety	
Air Quality	Products should not contribute to the production of smog, ozone or induce poor indoor air quality through Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC).
Aquatic Toxicity	Products will not be toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms.
Aquatic Biodegradability	Products should biodegrade readily, in less than 28 days, so they are not persistent in the environment.
Packaging	Primary packaging must be recyclable, or manufacturers must provide for return and refill option.
